COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 882, L.D. 1226, Bill, "An Act to Assure Access to Nutrition Programs for Kindergarten and Part-day Students"

Amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) the following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Reimbursement for State Mandates

All Other \$48,570

Provides funds to cover the initial costs of the state mandate that all public schools with greater than 40% needy children must participate in the National School Breakfast Program.

FISCAL NOTE

4 This bill requires that all public schools participate in
6 the National School Breakfast Program. As a result of the state
8 mandate law, the State is required to pay 100% of the additional
10 costs incurred during the first 2 years of the mandate. After
12 the first 2 years, these additional costs will be paid through
14 the school subsidy formula. The maximum future additional
16 appropriations required are \$48,570 in fiscal year 1991-92, and
18 \$31,250 in fiscal year 1992-93 and thereafter. However, the
20 State's cost would be reduced to the extent that school units
22 exercise the option of collecting meal fees from students who are
eligible for reduced price or full price meals.'
