An Act Relating to the Issuance of Any-deer Permits.



1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3 12 MRSA §7076, sub-§13 is enacted to read:

5 13. Antlerless deer permits. During any year an antlerless
7 deer permit system is implemented, each person who receives a
9 complimentary license to hunt under subsection 1, 3, 4 or 4-A or
11 any person eligible to receive a complimentary license to hunt
13 under subsection 1, 3, 4, or 4-A and receives a supersport
15 license under subsection 12 in lieu of a complimentary license
17 shall also be issued a complimentary antlerless deer permit
pursuant to section 7457, subsection 1, paragraph H.

13 STATEMENT OF FACT

15 This bill automatically provides an antlerless deer permit
17 for persons eligible to receive a complimentary hunting license
due to age or disability.
