17 19	Amend the amendment in section 11 by striking out all of that pirt designated " <u>§7110.</u> " (page 2, lines 35 to 51 and page 3, lines 1 to 9 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:
21	<u>'§7110. Unconventional weapon deer hunting license</u>
23	
25 27	1. Issuance; eligibility. The commissioner shall issue to eligible persons a license to hunt deer with an unconventional weapon during any open season on deer. Licenses issued pursuant to this section shall be valid for only one type of
29	unconventional weapon and shall specify that type of weapon on the license.
31	2. Eligibility. Any person is eligible for a license to hunt deer with an unconventional weapon if that person:
33	A. Is suffering from the loss of both arms above the elbow;
35	and
37	B. Can demonstrate, to the satisfaction of the commissioner, proficiency with that weapon, including
39	knowledge of safety skills and responsible hunting practices relevant to that weapon.
41	3. Schedule of fees. The schedule of fees for this license
43	shall be the same schedule of fees for other licenses provided in section 7101 which allow the licensee to take deer, subject to
45	any special privileges in section 7076.
47	4. Applicability of laws. Except as provided in this section, the provisions of chapters 701 to 721 relating to deer
49	shall be applicable to the taking of deer with a license issued pursuant to this section.
