An Act Authorizing Changes to the Budget Process in York County.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
30-A MRSA c. 3, sub-c. I, art. 8 is enacted to read:
ARTICLE 8. YORK COUNTY BUDGET COMMITTEE
§871. Definitions
<u>As used in this article, unless the context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the following meanings.</u>
<ol> <li>County commissioners. "County commissioners" means the elected county commissioners of York County.</li> </ol>
2. Municipal officials. "Municipal officials" may include the mayor, aldermen, councillors or manager of a city, the selectmen, councillors or manager of a town and the assessors of
a plantation located in York County.
3. Municipal officers. "Municipal officers" means the elected mayor, aldermen or councillors of a city, the selectmen
or councillors of a town and the assessors of a plantation located in York County.
§872. York County Budget Committee
In York County there is established the York County Budget Committee to carry out the purposes of this article.
1. Membership. The budget committee shall consist of 9
members, 3 members from each commissioner district selected at least 90 days before the end of the fiscal year as provided for
in this section.
<u>A. Of the 3 members from each commissioner district, one</u> must be a municipal official and one must be a
representative of the general public. All 3 members shall be appointed by the county commissioners.
<u>One member of the general public on the committee must be a</u>
resident of the unorganized territories. No other member of the general public on the committee may be a resident of the
unorganized territories.
<u>B. It is the responsibility of the county budget committee</u> to review the budget and estimates, including the budget for
<u>municipal services in the unorganized territory prepared by the county commissioners, and to make recommendations</u>

1	(1) The member who is a municipal officer, appointed by the county commissioners, has an initial term of one
3	year;
5	(2) The member who is a representative of the general public, appointed by the county commissioners, has an
7	initial term of 2 years; and
9	(3) The 3rd member has an initial term of 3 years.
11	The terms of the respective members shall increase by one year at the time of reappointment, except the 3-year term,
13	which shall become a one-year term.
15	D. A vacancy occurring on the budget committee shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointment for
17	the balance of the unexpired term. The person appointed to fill the vacant office must have the same qualifications as
19	the person vacating the office.
21	E. Members shall serve without compensation.
23	<u>§873. Budget committee organization</u>
25	The budget committee shall conduct its meetings in public at the county courthouse. The county commissioners shall direct the
27	<u>county clerk to call an organizational meeting of the budget</u> committee within 15 days after the county budget has been
29	prepared by the county commissioners. The county commissioners shall provide the committee with necessary clerical assistance,
31	office expenses and suitable meeting space, as well as access to county files and information. The budget committee shall select
33	its own chair, vice-chair and secretary. The budget committee shall adopt its own rules or procedures and bylaws.
35	<u>§874. Budget procedures</u>
37	1. Proposed budget. The county commissioners shall submit
39	itemized budget estimates, as described in sections 701, 702 and 7503, to the budget committee in a timely fashion, no later than
41	90 days before the end of the county's fiscal year.
43	2. Budget review process. The budget committee shall review the proposed itemized budgets prepared by the county
45	commissioners, together with any supplementary material prepared
47	by the head of each county department or provided by any independent board, institution or another governmental agency.
49	The budget committee may make recommendations concerning any increase, decrease, alteration or revision to the proposed
51	budget. These activities shall be done before November 1st.

 <u>3. Meeting with legislative delegation. Before November</u> 15th, the county commissioners shall meet with the county legislative delegation to review and finalize estimates for the year.

Public hearing. The county commissioners shall hold a 4. 7 public hearing in the county on the proposed budget prior to December 1st and before the final adoption of the budget. Notice 9 of the hearing shall be given at least 10 days before the hearing in all newspapers of general circulation within the county. 11 Written notice and a copy of the proposed budget shall be sent by mail or delivered in person to the clerk of each municipality in 13 the county and to the members of the budget committee. The municipal clerk shall notify the municipal officials of the 15 proposed budget and the date of the public hearing.

- 17 <u>5. Adoption of budget. After the public hearing is completed, the county commissioners may further increase, decrease, alter and revise the proposed itemized budgets provided that:</u>
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- A. The county commissioners shall enter into their minutes23and submit to the budget committee a statement of their<br/>bases for any rejection of any recommendation of the budget25committee; and
- 27 <u>B. The county commissioners shall hold a public meeting</u> prior to December 7th with the budget committee to discuss
   29 <u>any rejections.</u>
- 31 The proposed itemized budget must be finally adopted by a majority vote of the county commissioners at a duly called 33 meeting not later than December 15th.

35 Interim approval by legislative delegation. Before б. submitting the budget to the Legislature under subsection 7, the 37 county commissioners shall submit the proposed budget to the legislative delegation. The delegation shall render a decision 39 by January 1st. Failure to do so is considered approval of the budget as submitted. If the legislative delegation disapproves 41 of the budget, the county commissioners shall submit, within 15 calendar days, new budget proposals in accordance with subsection 43 1 and the provisions of this section shall be followed until a budget is approved by the legislative delegation. 45

- 7. Final budget approval. Before January 15th of the
   47 fiscal year for which the budget is prepared, the county commissioners shall submit the proposed budget to the
   49 Legislature. The Legislature shall approve, disapprove or amend the budget as submitted.
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 8. Assessment of taxes. The budget as approved by the Legislature is the final authorization for the assessment of county taxes. The budget shall be sent to the county commissioners and the county tax authorized shall be apportioned
 and collected in accordance with section 706. The budget for the unorganized territories shall be sent to the State as provided by section 7503.

9 9. Interim budget. Until a budget is finally adopted, the county shall operate on an interim budget which shall not exceed
 11 the previous year's budget.

**10. Transfer** of **funds.** The county commissioners may transfer funds as provided in section 922.

## <u>§875. Budget amendments</u>

The approved budget shall govern the expenditures of the 19 county during the fiscal year. No expenses may be incurred in excess of those shown in the approved budget, but the budget may 21 be from time to time revised by the preparation of a proposed amended budget by the county commissioners. This proposed 23 amended budget shall be submitted to the county budget committee for review. Any recommendations by this committee must be 25 submitted within 10 calendar days. After receiving the recommendation of the budget committee, the county commissioners 27 shall forward the proposed revised budget to the legislative delegation for approval. The delegation has 10 calendar days to 29 render a decision on the proposed revision. Failure of the delegation to render a decision within the specified time is 31 considered an approval of the revision. If the delegation disapproves of the revision, the procedure of section 874, 33 subsection 6, shall be followed. The county commissioners shall submit the proposed revised budget to the Legislature for 35 approval, disapproval or amendment. If approved, the Legislature shall transmit a report of approval of a revised budget to the 37 State Auditor within 15 days of that approval.

39 §876. Filing of county budget

A copy of the final budget and subsequent amendments shall
 be filed, on forms approved by the Department of Audit, with the
 State Auditor, who shall retain them for 3 years.
