HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 905,
L.D. 1262, Bill, "An Act to Revise the Medical Examiner Act"

Amend the amendment in subsection 1 by striking out all of
the last underlined sentence (page 1, lines 30 to 34 in
amendment) and inserting in its place the following: 'A person
participating in good faith in the provision of information,
samples or specimens under this section is immune from any civil
or criminal liability for that act or for otherwise cooperating
with the Chief Medical Examiner.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies the immunity language in the
amendment and adopts the same language presently establishing
immunity for reporting suspected child abuse in the Maine Revised
Statutes, Title 22, section 4014.
