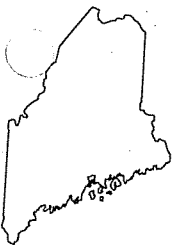

An Act Concerning Wide Loads.

---



1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3 29 MRSA §1702-A is enacted to read:

5 §1702-A. Prohibition of wide loads on Carlton Bridge

7 Notwithstanding any permit issued pursuant to section 1703,  
9 no vehicle which is in excess of the width restriction as set out  
11 in section 1701 may cross the Carlton Bridge connecting Bath and  
13 Woolwich, between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. and 3:00  
15 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. This prohibition shall take effect when  
17 notice is conspicuously posted at each end of the bridge.

17 STATEMENT OF FACT

19 The purpose of this bill is to prohibit wide loads crossing  
the Carlton Bridge during rush hour.
