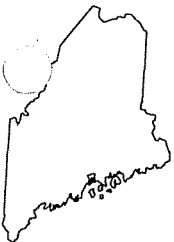

NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Establish a Contingency Account for Certain Municipalities.



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **Sec. 1. Contingency fund.** A fund shall be established for the
5 purpose of giving financial assistance to municipalities that
7 incur expenses as a result of providing security for the
9 President of the United States and the members of the President's
11 family while they are within the State. The fund shall be
administered by the Bureau of State Police. The bureau shall
promulgate rules pursuant to the Maine Administrative Procedure
Act, Title 5, chapter 375, governing the procedures for making
applications to and distributions from the fund.

13 **Sec. 2. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated
15 from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
