HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 920, L.D. 1286, Bill, "An Act to Prohibit Boarding Care Facility and Nursing Home Facility Personnel from Smoking"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in the first line (page 1, line 27 in amendment) by striking out the following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "§1580-B." by striking out all of the first paragraph (page 1, lines 31 to 35 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'The following provisions apply to smoking in nursing homes licensed under chapter 405 and boarding care facilities licensed under chapter 1665 which are constructed as nursing homes or boarding care facilities after October 1, 1989.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of sections 2, 3 and 4

Further amend the amendment by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The construction costs incurred for an enclosed smoking area in nursing homes and boarding care facilities would be included in the reimbursement rate established by the Department of Human Services and would result in increased payments to providers.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment provides that enclosed smoking areas are required only for nursing homes and boarding care facilities

which are constructed after October 1, 1989.
