STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment reflects the fact that garages are included in the home construction contract law by stating that the warranty shall cover other appropriate uses in addition to habitation. It changes the definition of "change orders" to include any revision, not just a revision upward. This change makes the revised section consistent with other sections of the current law.
