An Act Concerning Payment of Law Enforcement Training Costs.

5	A-1. "Private sector" means any firm, corporation, partnership or other organization, association or group,

11	2. Reimbursement for training costs. Whenever a law
13	enforcement officer, trained at the Maine Criminal Justice
15	Academy on or after September 1, 1983, while on the payroll of a particular governmental entity, is subsequently hired by another
	governmental entity or the private sector in a capacity that
17	would require the officer to use the training acquired at the academy within 3 years of his graduation from the academy, the
19	governmental entity or the private sector shall reimburse the
	first governmental entity according to the following formula.
21	A. If the officer is hired by the other governmental entity
23	or private sectors during the first year after his graduation, that governmental entity or private sectors
25	shall reimburse the first governmental entity the full cost of the training costs.

	The purpose of this bill is to broaden the scope of the law
13	so that the private sector has to reimburse a municipality when
	it hires a police officer after the municipality has paid to have
15	the officer trained.
