13	COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " $\hat{A}$ " to H.P. 936, L.D. 1304, Bill, "An Act to Promote Energy Conservation and Load Management by
15	Electric Utilities"
17	Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its
19	place the following:
21	'35-A MRSA §3153-A, sub-§3 is enacted to read:
23	3. Implementation of rebate structures. The Public Utilities Commission may require an electric utility to implement
25	rebate structures for installation or upgrade of an electric service entrance to encourage energy efficient buildings and
27	discourage energy inefficient buildings. In designing these programs, the commission shall give due consideration to safety.

31	FISCAL NOTE
33	The Public Utilities Commission could incur some minor additional administrative expenses to implement the proposed
35	rebate structures. The costs can be absorbed within existing budget resources.'

39	STATEMENT OF FACT
41	The amendment removes the proposal to grant authority to the
43	Public Utilities Commission to impose special fees on electric utility customers who install a new or upgrade an existing
45	electrical service entrance. It retains the prohibition in existing law against charging hookup fees in excess of the cost
47	of installing the service. The intent of the amendment is to give the Public Utilities Commission the option of providing
49	incentive rebates for energy efficient buildings but not to impose additional fees for installing electricity.
51	The amendment also eliminates a 2nd part of the original

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 936, L.D. 1304

 bill which would have prohibited utilities from including in their rate base any costs associated with promoting electric
heating systems.

5 Finally, the amendment adds a fiscal note.
