STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Permit Private Educational Institutions of Higher Learning to Make Purchases through the State Purchasing Agent.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

5 MRSA §1812, 2nd ¶, as repealed and replaced by PL 1987, c. 402, Pt. A, §43, is amended to read:

The Trustees of the University of Maine System, or of any other institution of higher learning located in the State, may authorize the Department of Administration to act for them in any purchases.

STATEMENT OF FACT

At present, the branches of the University of Maine System enjoy an advantage over private institutions of higher learning in the State in the purchase of services, supplies, materials and equipment because they are authorized to purchase through the State Purchasing Agent. This bill eliminates that advantage by allowing all such institutions to make purchases through the State.
