IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Ban the Use of Polystyrene Containers.

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §1652, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 804, is repealed.
5	Sec. 2. 38 MRSA §1652-A is enacted to read:
7	<u>§1652. Sales of food or beverages in polystyrene foam containers</u>
9	<u>A food service providing or serving individual portions of</u>
11	food or a beverage shall not provide or serve those portions in
13	<u>or on containers that are composed in whole or in part of polystyrene foam plastic.</u>
15	Sec. 3. Effective date. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 1990.
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19	STATEMENT OF FACT
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23	Last year, the Legislature passed a law banning the use of polystyrene containers in food service facilities in government buildings. This bill extends that prohibition to all food
25	service facilities in the State.
