COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 942, L.D. 1310, Bill, "An Act Regarding the Removal of Hazardous Chemicals from Schools"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'20-A MRSA §15613, sub-§14 is enacted to read:

14. Hazardous chemicals. The Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services shall establish rules governing the purchase and storage of hazardous chemicals in schools. These rules shall be established prior to January 1, 1990.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect on July 1, 1989.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment replaces the original bill and directs the Department of Educational and Cultural Services to establish rules for the storage of hazardous chemicals in schools. In addition, the amendment removes the appropriation.
