13	COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " H " to H.P. 948, L.D. 1316, Bill, "An Act for the Preservation of Affordable Rental Housing in Maine"

17	Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:
19	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
21	as emergencies; and
23	Whereas, current law preserving rental housing for low-income households will expire on August 1, 1989; and
25	
27	Whereas, 2,000 rental units will be at risk in 1990 and 18,000 units will be at risk over the next decade; and
29	Whereas, no new federally subsidized low-income rental units have been constructed since 1984 while, at the same time,
31	the number of low-income households has increased significantly; and
33	
35	Whereas, it is necessary to preserve as many of these low-income rental units as possible for low-income households; and

37	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
39	Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
41	safety; now, therefore,'
43	Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:
45	-
47	' Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.

3	FISCAL NOTE
5	Enactment of this bill may result in additional costs to the Maine State Housing Authority. These costs can be absorbed
7	within existing resources.'
9	STATEMENT OF FACT
11	This amendment adds an emergency preamble and an emergency
13	clause to the bill in order for the bill to take effect before the current law expires on August 1, 1989. The amendment also
15	adds a fiscal note.
