HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 950,
L.D. 1318, "Resolve, to Establish a Commission to Study Town
Supervision of Private Roads"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 2nd, 3rd and
4th paragraph after the title (page 1, line 22 to 38 in
amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the resolve by striking out all of that part
designated "Appointment" (page 2, lines 13 to 43 in L.D.) and
inserting in its place the following:

'Appointment. Resolved: That the commission shall consist
of 7 members, appointed in the following manner:

1. Two Senators appointed by the President of the Senate,
including one from the Joint Standing Committee on Transportation
and one from the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local
Government; and 3 members of the House of Representatives
appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives,
including 2 from the Joint Standing Committee on Transportation
and one from the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local
Government. The President of the Senate and Speaker of the House
of Representatives, jointly, shall select a chair from the
legislative members;

2. One Executive Department official selected by the
Governor;

3. A representative of the Maine Municipal Association to
be appointed by that organization; and

4. A representative of the Governor's Municipal Advisory
Council chosen by the council.

Each person required to make an appointment or appointments
under this resolve shall make the appointment or appointments by

1 July 10, 1989, and shall inform the President of the Senate, the
2 Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Executive Director
3 of the Legislative Council and the Governor upon making the
4 appointment or appointments.

7 the first meeting no later than August 1, 1989; and be it
