FISCAL NOTE 37

> This bill implements but delays funding of the Maine Choice Program. When funding is provided to the Maine Choice Program, the Department of Educational and Cultural Services, Division of Higher Education Services, will require an additional part-time position to administer the program. The division will be able to absorb the additional costs of the advisory board and rulemaking.

> The Department of Labor will incur additional costs beginning in fiscal year 1991-92 for the compilation and annual update of the health care occupations manual.

> The Department of Human Services and the Maine Health Policy Advisory Council will provide the services and fulfill the responsibilities described in this bill, to the extent that existing resources are available to do so.'
