IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Amend the Liquor Laws Relating to Wine Tasting.

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
. 3	28-A MRSA §1205 is enacted to read:
5	<u>§1205. Taste testing of wine</u>
7	 <u>1. Taste testing on off-premise retail licensee's</u> premises. Subject to the conditions in subsection 2, an
9	off-premise retail license authorizes the person to whom it is issued to conduct taste testings of wine on that licensee's
11	<u>premises. Any other consumption of alcoholic beverages on an</u> off-premise retail licensee's premises is prohibited.
13	2 Conditions on tosts testing patimities The following
15	Conditions on taste-testing activities. The following conditions apply to taste-testing activities under this section.
17	A. No wine may be served to persons who have not yet attained the age of 21 years;
19	
21	<u>B. No person may be served more than a total of 5 ounces of wine;</u>
23	<u>C. No person may be charged a fee for any wine served as part of a taste-testing activity;</u>
25	
27	D. No person may be served who is legally intoxicated;
29	E. Taste testing shall be limited to a designated area;
31	F. Taste testing shall be conducted within the hours of retail sale established in this Title;
33	<u>G. The retail licensee must obtain the written permission</u> of the commissioner before conducting any taste-testing
35	<u>activity;</u>
37	<u>H. Taste testing shall not be conducted or permitted on a regular or daily basis; and</u>
39	
41	I. Taste testing is not allowed in any municipality where on-premise and off-premise sales are not allowed pursuant to chapter 5.

45	STATEMENT OF FACT

49	This bill allows holders of off-premise retail liquor licenses to conduct taste testings of wine on the premises under certain conditions.
