HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 486,
L.D. 1328, Bill, "An Act Providing Confidentiality for Public
Sector Job Applicants"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 1 in
paragraph A in the 4th and 5th lines (page 1, lines 35 and 36 in
the amendment) by striking out the following: "confidence
pertaining to the applicant hired." and inserting in its place
the following: 'confidence, pertaining to the applicant hired'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 1 in
paragraph B in the last line (page 1, line 41 in the amendment)
by inserting after the underlined word "letter" the underlined
words 'or note'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in paragraph A by
striking out all of subparagraph (1) (page 2, lines 18 to 23 in
the amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'(1) Notwithstanding any confidentiality provision
other than this paragraph, applications, resumes and
letters and notes of reference, other than those
letters and notes of reference expressly submitted in
confidence, pertaining to the applicant hired are
public records after the applicant is hired.'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in paragraph A in
subparagraph (2) in the last line (page 2, line 27 in the
amendment) by inserting after the underlined word "letter" the
following: 'or note'

Further amend the amendment in section 3 in paragraph A in
subparagraph (1) in the 5th line (page 3, line 2 in the
amendment) by striking out the following: "confidence pertaining
to the applicant hired." and inserting in its place the
following: 'confidence, pertaining to the applicant hired'
