SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 486, L.D. 1328, Bill, "An Act Providing Confidentiality for Public Sector Job Applicants"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 1 by striking out all of paragraph A (page 1, lines 32 to 37 in the amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'A. Notwithstanding any confidentiality provision other than this subsection, applications and resumes of applicants for major policy-influencing positions who are interviewed by the hiring authority or its designees are public records.'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 1 in paragraph B in the last line (page 1, line 41 in the amendment) by inserting after the underlined word "letter" the underlined words 'or note'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in paragraph A by striking out all of subparagraph (1) (page 2, lines 18 to 23 in the amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'(1) Notwithstanding any confidentiality provision other than this subsection, applications and resumes of applicants for major policy-influencing positions who are interviewed by the hiring authority or its designees are public records.'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in paragraph A in subparagraph (2) in the last line (page 2, line 27 in the amendment) by inserting after the underlined word "letter" the following: 'or note'

Further amend the amendment in section 3 in paragraph A by striking out all of subparagraph (1) and inserting in its place the following:

1                   '(1) Notwithstanding any confidentiality provision  
3                   other than this subsection, applications and resumes of  
5                   applicants for major policy-influencing positions who  
                  are interviewed by the hiring authority or its  
                  designees are public records.'

7                   Further amend the amendment in section 3 in paragraph A in


