**STATEMENT OF FACT**

3           This bill provides for funds to increase the State's  
4 contribution for the group accident, sickness or health insurance  
5 on behalf of eligible retired teachers. The State presently  
6 provides 100% payment of group accident and sickness or health  
7 insurance on behalf of state employees. This bill provides  
8 parity between retired teachers and retired state employees by  
9 increasing the percentage of state payment of health insurance  
10 for retired teachers from 15% to 100%.
