COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 965, L.D. 1343, Bill, "An Act Concerning Fishing Licenses for Developmentally Disabled Persons"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

12 MRSA §7076, sub-§13 is enacted to read:

13. Mentally retarded person. A 3-year complimentary license to fish shall be issued to any mentally retarded person, as defined in Title 20-A, section 7001, subsection 3, upon application to the commissioner.

**FISCAL NOTE**

Enactment of this legislation could result in a loss of dedicated revenue to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. The amount cannot be determined at this time since it is unknown how many people over the age of 16 fall under the definition of "mentally retarded" and currently purchase fishing licenses.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment provides a 3-year complimentary fishing license for mentally retarded persons and adds a fiscal note.
