An Act Concerning Fishing Licenses for Developmentally Disabled Persons.



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **12 MRSA §7151, sub-§1, ¶D** is enacted to read:

5 D. Any mentally retarded person, as defined in Title 20-A,
7 section 7001, subsection 3, may fish without a license, but
9 must be accompanied by an adult.

11 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

13 This bill would allow mentally retarded persons to fish
without a license only if accompanied by an adult.
