COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 978, L.D. 1356, Bill, "An Act to Authorize County Commissioners to Provide Additional Facilities for Prisoners"

Amend the bill in section 1 in the first paragraph after the amending clause by striking out all of the 2nd sentence (page 1, lines 25 and 26 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: 'These prisoners must be involved in restitution, work or educational release, or rehabilitative programs.'

Further amend the bill by inserting after the emergency clause and before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Corrections will utilize existing staff to conduct the inspections of an anticipated 3 or 4 new prisoner housing sites each year. The additional costs associated with these inspections will be absorbed within existing resources.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment provides that prisoners who are housed in facilities outside the jail must be in restitution, work or educational release, or rehabilitative programs that involve housing outside the jail setting. The original language merely allowed programs to be provided in connection with these facilities.

The amendment also adds a fiscal note.
