19	last sentence and inserting in its place the following: 'Notwithstanding Title 17-A, section 1301, an individual
21	<u>convicted of illegal fishing of Atlantic salmon, in violation of section 7603, shall be fined \$500 per fish, not to be suspended.</u>
23	and up to \$1,000 per violation.'
25	Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

	It is anticipated that enactment of this bill could result
31	in an increase in the collection of fines by the Judicial Department in the amount of \$75,000 in fiscal year 1989-90 and
33	\$100,000 in fiscal year 1990-91, which will be dedicated to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. The Judicial
35	Department would absorb any additional costs resulting from an
37	expected increase in court filings.'
39	STATEMENT OF FACT
41	This amendment revises the penalty for illegal fishing of Atlantic salmon and adds a fiscal note.
