1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	12 MRSA §7901, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 420, §1, is amended to read:

	3. A violation of any of the acts prohibited in chapter
7	711, subchapter III, fishing violations, is a Class E crime, except that in addition to any penalty which the court might
9	impose, a convicted person shall be fined \$5 for each fish illegally possessed, this fine not to be suspended.
11	Notwithstanding Title 17-A, section 1301, an individual convicted
	of illegal netting of Atlantic salmon shall be fined \$1000, which
13	shall not be suspended.
