23 .	Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the
25	enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:
27	'Sec. 1. Legislative findings. The Sunapee charr, Salvelinus
29	alpinus oquassa, is a unique species of fish found in large numbers only in Floods Pond in the Town of Otis, in Hancock
31	County. The protection of Sunapee charr habitat at Floods Pond is essential to the future survival of this unique species.
3 3	Floods Pond serves as the major water supply for the Bangor
	area. The drain on Floods Pond by the Bangor Water District to satisfy the water needs of the Bangor area causes annual
35	fluctuations in the water level. Extreme drawdowns in the water level at Floods Pond pose a serious threat to the habitat
37	necessary for Sunapee charr reproduction. Water demands in the
39	Bangor area are likely to increase over the next several years as a result of increased development.

41	Sec. 2. Sunapee charr habitat protection; plan required. The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife and the Bangor Water
