An Act to Equalize State Retiree Health Benefits.



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5	MRSA	285.	sub-§	9	is	ena	cted	to	read:

9. Supplemental coverage; Medicare eligible retirees. For those retirees who are otherwise eligible for coverage under this section, but are also Medicare eligible, the Maine State Retirement System shall pay 100% of only the retirees' share of the premiums for Medicare Part B and a supplemental group policy which has the effect of making the deductibles and coverages for Medicare eligible retirees equal to those provided non-Medicare eligible retirees under this section.

STATEMENT OF FACT

State retirees who meet statutory criteria have been covered under the state health insurance plan for many years. An increasing number have been required to enroll under Medicare in recent years. This has resulted in less coverage for these retirees because the Medicare plan has greater out-of-pocket expenses. This bill requires the State to maintain its original commitment to all retirees by paying Medicare premiums and providing supplemental insurance to equalize Medicare benefits with the state plan.
