29	Enactment of this bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$6,590 in fiscal year 1989-90 to fund the per diem, meeting
31	and related expenses of the Commission to Study the Feasibility of Establishing a Piscataqua River Basin Compact between Maine
33	and New Hampshire. Also, it is anticipated that all costs associated with providing staff assistance to the commission
35	would be absorbed by the Department of Conservation utilizing existing resources.'

39	STATEMENT OF FACT
41	This amendment changes the original bill by requiring a
43	progress report on the activities of the Commission to Study the Feasibility of Establishing a Piscataqua River Basin Compact
45	between Maine and New Hampshire next December rather than a final report. It also shifts the staffing responsibility for the
47	commission to the rivers coordinator of the Department of Conservation.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to S.P. 496, L.D. 1370

Because Maine needs the cooperation of New Hampshire to develop this initiative, the amendment requires New Hampshire to pass similar legislation for this resolve to become effective. Finally, this amendment authorizes the commission to draft language to form a compact between Maine and New Hampshire for joint management of the river and its resources.
