An Act to Improve Foster Care in the State.



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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

All Other \$1,000,000

Provides \$500,000 to fund additional foster care worker positions and to provide for educational programs aimed at enhancing the skills of existing foster care workers and, in addition, provides \$500,000 to fund additional therapeutic foster care homes.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides funding for foster care worker positions, educational programs and additional therapeutic foster care homes.
