COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 499, L.D. 1373, Bill, "An Act to Restrict Use of Antifreeze or Other Toxic Agents on Lakes, Ponds and Streams"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and inserting in its place the following:

'An Act to Clarify That the Use of Antifreeze or Other Toxic Agents on Lakes, Ponds and Streams Is Illegal'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'12 MRSA §7573 is enacted to read:

§7573. Illegal use of antifreeze

Adding substances containing ethylene glycol or other antifreeze agents to the waters of this State is a violation of Title 38, section 413.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies that it is illegal to use antifreeze while ice fishing.
