An Act to Establish a License Fee Schedule for Restaurants.



Т	be it enacted by the reopie of the State of Maine as follows:
3	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §2494, sub-§§2 and 3, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 838, §1, are amended to read:
