IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Authorize Special Maine National Guard Motor Vehicle Registration Plates.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

29 MRSA §252-H is enacted to read:

§252-H. Maine National Guard special license plates

On the application of an active member of the Maine Army or Air National Guard whose active status is certified by the Adjutant General and the payment of the excise tax required by Title 36, section 1482, the Secretary of State shall issue a registration certificate and a set of special designated plates, to be used in lieu of regular plates to designate the vehicle as belonging to an active member of the Maine Army or Air National Guard. The Secretary of State may design these special plates which shall carry the word "Maine" across the top, a minuteman logo on the left, numerals in the center and the words "National Guard" across the bottom. The special registration plates for members of the Maine Army or Air National Guard may be used only on one motor vehicle whose registered gross weight shall not exceed 9,000 pounds.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to authorize the issuance and purchase of distinctive license plates to active members of the Maine Army and Air National Guard for use on their personal vehicles. These distinctive plates will help identify and to facilitate movement in case of emergency and to enhance recruiting and retention programs within the Maine National Guard.
