SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 506, L.D. 1394, Bill, "An Act Making Changes to the Composition of the Governor's Advisory Council on Alcoholism"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §7108, first ¶, as amended by PL 1983, c. 464, §13, is further amended to read:

The council shall consist of no more than 25 30 members who, excepting members representing the Legislature, shall be appointed by the Governor. To be qualified to serve, members shall have education, training, experience, knowledge, expertise and interest in drug abuse prevention and training. Members shall be residents of different geographical areas of the State, who reflect experiential diversity and concern for drug abuse prevention and treatment in the State.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) the following: 'Sec. 2.' '

Further amend the amendment in the first paragraph after the title in the first line (page 1, line 17 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Amend" and inserting in its place the following: 'Further amend'

Further amend the amendment in the 2nd paragraph after the title in the first line (page 1, line 22 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Amend" and inserting in its place the following: 'Further amend'
