STATEMENT OF FACT

29 This bill provides funds to the Southern Maine
31 Vocational-Technical Institute to increase its vocational and
33 technical education programs in southern Maine for businesses,
35 industries, municipal government and health fields. With a
37 rapidly growing population and increasing industrial and business
39 activities, there is a need for vocational and technical
41 education designed to upgrade the skills of existing workers in
southern Maine. The Southern Maine Vocational-Technical
Institute will offer programs which will allow working people
with economic constraints to upgrade their skills in key
technologies, such as electronics, drafting design, computer
sciences, communications, hospitality industries, construction
technologies, municipal services and health occupations.
