An Act to Establish a Fund to Provide Education for Emergency Medical Service Personnel Statewide and to Provide Matching Funds for Equipment for Emergency Medical Services.

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1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §2303-A is enacted to read:
5	<u>§2303-A. Mandatory addition to penalty</u>
7	1. Fee imp osed. In addition to the penalties provided in section 2303 or other penalties provided in this Title, a \$25 fee
9	shall be imposed on any person convicted of a moving violation under this Title that results in an accident.
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13	2. Funds dedicated. Funds generated by the fee provided in subsection 1 shall be dedicated to the Emergency Medical Services Fund established in Title 32, section 88-A.
