IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Require Big Game Hunters to Obtain Written Permission Before Hunting on Private Property.

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	12 MRSA §7408 is enacted to read:
5	<u>§7408. Permission; private property</u>
7	Before hunting deer, moose or bear on private property not owned by corporations in organized municipalities, every resident
9	or nonresident must obtain written permission from the owner or
	lessee of that land or the owner's or lesee's agent.

	1. Expire. The permission given expires at the end of the
13	<u>regular firearms hunting season. Permission must be obtained</u>
	from the owner every season.

17	2. Produce permission. The written permission must be kept
17	in the person's possession while hunting, and the person must produce the permission when requested to do so by any law
19	enforcement officer or the property owner.

21	3. Posted land; exception. No permission is required if
	the owner has posted the land, indicating that hunting is
23	permitted on the land.
