An Act Concerning Fishing Regulations in Aroostook County.



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7552, sub-§5, ¶D,** as amended by PL 1987, c.
115, §1, is further amended to read:

5
7 D. The commissioner may issue a rule establishing an annual
opening date as the last Saturday of April on waters
reclaimed by the removal of rough fish; and

11 **Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7552, sub-§5, ¶G,** as enacted by PL 1983, c.
274, §3, is amended to read:

13 G. There shall be a continued closed season on the dipping
15 of smelts from Morrill Pond and its tributaries in Somerset
County; and

17 **Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §7552, sub-§5, ¶H** is enacted to read:

19 H. The open season in Aroostook County for all fish in
21 rivers, brooks and streams shall be from May 1st to
September 15th and from May 1st to October 31st for all fish
23 in lakes and ponds.
