IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Expand State Agency Access to Applicant Lists.

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

5 MRSA §7036, sub-§5, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 785, Pt. B, §38, is amended to read:

5. Be responsible for the development and implementation of the system of registers of eligibles. Be responsible for the development and use of registers of eligibles and the updating of these registers in accordance with policies and procedures approved by the Policy Review Board.

The director shall make available to a state agency which seeks13to fill a vacant or new position the entire list of eligible<br/>candidates together with information on the candidates and on15their ranking, if any, within the group of eligible candidates.

17 The director shall implement the procedures authorized by this subsection with the goal to establish an efficient hiring process 19 that meets the satisfaction of the agencies that the office serves;

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## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill allows any state agency which has a vacant position to have access to the entire list of applicants held by the Bureau of Human Resources. Current policy is that the lists are released by the bureau only at 6-month intervals.
