41	This amendment removes the emergency preamble and clause of the resolve which are in violation of the Constitution of Maine, Article IV, Part Third, Section 16.

45	This amendment also requires the Hallowell Water District to restore the land to its former condition, including drainage and
47	topographical features, following completion of the excavation and laying of the water main. If the Hallowell Water District exceeds the scope of its easement, the State will enforce its
49	rights and jurisdiction according to provisions of Maine law.
