**Resolve, to Establish a Study Commission Regarding Incentives for
Recycling of Solid Waste by Commercial Facilities.**



1 **Sec. 1. Commission established; study. Resolved:** That there is
2 established the Commission to Study Solid Waste Recycling. The
3 commission shall study the incentives to encourage commercial
4 recycling of 100% of solid waste; and be it further

5
6 **Sec. 2. Membership; appointment. Resolved:** That the
7 commission shall be comprised of the following 6 members: 2
8 members from the private sector to be appointed by the Governor;
9 2 members from the Bureau of Taxation, to be appointed by the
10 Commissioner of Finance; and 2 from the environmental field to be
11 appointed by the Commissioner of Environmental Protection; and be
12 it further

13
14 **Sec. 3. Compensation. Resolved:** That all members of the
15 commission who are not state employees shall receive
16 reimbursement for expenses only upon application to the
17 Department of Finance; and be it further

18
19 **Sec. 4. Staff assistance. Resolved:** That, if assistance is
20 desired, the commission may request necessary staff assistance
21 from the Governor; and be it further

22
23 **Sec. 5. Report. Resolved:** That the commission shall submit a
24 report together with any necessary implementing legislation to
25 the Second Regular Session of the 114th Legislature by December
26 1, 1989; and be it further

27
28 **Sec. 6. Appropriation. Resolved:** That the following funds are
29 appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of
30 this resolve.
