STATEMENT OF FACT
The amendment strikes the language creating a new section of
law setting forth an agent or broker property right in insurance
information, and prohibiting lenders from selling insurance
information obtained in the lending process. The amendment,
instead, adds language to the existing law prohibiting the use of
insurance information to the detriment of another to clarify that
the section prohibits selling and transferring of that
information.
