23	1321, a county referendum shall be held in Androscoggin County at the November 1989, regular election to determine whether a
25	charter commission should be established for the purpose of revising the charter or establishing a new charter for
27	Androscoggin County.
29	Insofar as it is not inconsistent with this resolve, the conduct of the referendum, commission membership, charter
31	amendments, submission to voters and judicial review shall be as set forth in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, chapter 11,
33	subchapter II.'

39	This amendment clarifies that the question of whether Androscoggin County should establish a charter commission will be submitted to the voters at the upcoming regular election to be
