Resolve, to Establish a Charter Commission to Review Androscoggin County Government .

(EMERGENCY)

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

5 Whereas, there is a critical need to revise Androscoggin County government to enhance its effectiveness and 7 accountability; and

9 Whereas, the publicly elected members of the commission to review Androscoggin County government will be elected in the
11 November 1989 elections; and

13 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 15 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 17 safety; now, therefore, be it

19 Charter commission established. Resolved: That notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, section 1321, a charter 21 commission is established for the purpose of revising the charter or establishing a new charter for Androscoggin County.

Insofar as it is not inconsistent with this resolve, 25 commission membership, charter amendments, submission to voters and judicial review shall be as set forth in the Maine Revised 27 Statutes, Title 30-A, chapter 11, subchapter II.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve establishes a charter commission to review the present form of county government in Androscoggin County, and to recommend revisions to enhance the effectiveness and accountability of Androscoggin County government.
