HOUSE AMENDMENT "**D**" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1025, L.D. 1431, Bill, "An Act to Promote Reduction, Recycling and Integrated Management of Solid Waste and Sound Environmental Regulation"

Amend the amendment in that part designated "**PART D**" in section 10 in the 11th line (page 71, line 47 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "sections 1 to 5." the following: 'If the department determines that the implementation of these provisions will clearly impose undue hardship on farmers which cannot be ameliorated except by exempting farmers from some or all of the requirements of sections 1 to 5, the department may do so through rulemaking.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment provides that the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources may, through rulemaking, exempt farmers from the provisions of the returnable container law if hardship is shown.
