HOUSE AMENDMENT "**E**" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1025, L.D. 1431, Bill, "An Act to Promote Reduction, Recycling and Integrated Management of Solid Waste and Sound Environmental Regulation"

Amend the amendment in that part designated "**PART E**" in section 34 by striking out all of the first paragraph (page 88 lines 48 to 52 and page 89 lines 1 and 2 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Notwithstanding the provisions of Title 1, section 302, the board shall not approve an application for a new commercial solid waste disposal facility after the effective date of this section, including any applications pending before the board on or after the effective date of this section. The board may relicense or approve a transfer of license for commercial solid waste disposal facilities after the effective date of this section, if those facilities had been previously licensed by the board prior to the effective date of this section, and all other provisions of law have been satisfied.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to ensure that there is no rush of applications for new commercial solid waste disposal facilities submitted in anticipation of passage of this legislation with the intent of circumventing legislative intent. As of June 18, 1989, there are no applications for new commercial solid waste disposal facilities as that term is defined in the legislation.
