SENATE AMENDMENT " D " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1025, L.D. 1431, Bill, "An Act to Promote Reduction, Recycling and Integrated Management of Solid Waste and Sound Environmental Regulation"

Amend the amendment in that part designated "PART E" in section 34 by striking out all of the 3rd and 4th lines (page 88, lines 48 to 49 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

'Notwithstanding the provisions of Title 1, section 302, the board shall not approve an application for a new commercial solid waste disposal facility after March 1, 1990, including any applications pending before the board on or after March 1, 1990.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies legislative intent that the Board of Environmental Protection shall not approve any application for a commercial solid waste disposal facility after March 1, 1990, including any applications pending before the board at that time. The purpose of this clarification is to ensure that there is no rush of applications for new commercial solid waste disposal facilities submitted in anticipation of passage of this legislation with the intent of circumventing legislative intent. As of June 18, 1989, there are no applications for new commercial solid waste disposal facilities as that term is defined in the legislation.
