HOUSE AMENDMENT "^A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1032, L.D. 1438, Bill, "An Act to Simplify the Process by Which People with Disabilities Are Able to Acquire Information and Apply for Services"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 2nd indented paragraph after the title (page 1, line 21 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'PART A

20-A MRSA §256, sub-§6 is enacted to read:'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the 4th indented paragraph after the title (page 1, line 26 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the bill by striking out all of Parts B and C.

Further amend the bill by relettering the Parts to read consecutively.'

FISCAL NOTE

It is anticipated that the changes established in this amendment can be absorbed within the existing resources established for this program.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment reinstates a technical change to the current benefits system that was included in the bill.
