STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment retains the intent of the bill to provide a 5 minimum subsidy calculated with reference to the operating cost subsidy only, but changes the wording of the bill. To calculate the minimum subsidy under the amendment, the Department of 7 Educational and Cultural Services would look at the state share percentage of operating costs of each school administrative unit, excluding consideration of any dollars the unit receives under 11 the "hold harmless" provision of the funding formula. If that percentage is less than 5%, the department will calculate the difference between the state share of operating costs and the 13 amount the unit would receive if the state share were 5%, and will add that amount to the unit's subsidy, without reducing any 15 other subsidy due the unit. This minimum subsidy differs from the current 5% minimum subsidy because that provision of law did 17 not provide additional money to a unit if it received subsidy from any category of school costs, such as operating, program or 19 debt service, in an amount equal to 5% of operating costs.
