

NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Provide Greater Legislative Oversight of Teacher and Administrative Certification.



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **Report to the Legislature.** The State Board of Education shall  
5 submit a report, at least biannually, by March 15 and September  
7 15, on the course and progress of the review of teacher and  
9 administrative certification which the board is conducting on the  
11 effective date of this Act. The reports shall be submitted to  
the joint standing committee of the Legislature having  
jurisdiction over education matters until such time as the State  
Board of Education completes its review and its recommendations  
have been fully implemented.

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**STATEMENT OF FACT**

17 The purpose of this bill is to increase legislative  
19 oversight of teacher and administrative certification issues by  
requiring the State Board of Education to report to the Joint  
Standing Committee on Education twice a year on the progress of a  
21 study and review currently being undertaken by the board.
